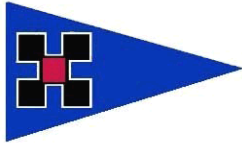

CASTINE CLASSIC YACHT RACE

Thursday, August 4, 2011

The **Castine Yacht Club**, in cooperation with the **Eggemoggin Reach Regatta**, is sponsoring the twelfth annual **Classic Yacht Race** from Castine to Camden on Thursday, August 4, with the first start at about 1145 hours. Last year's race attracted a magnificent fleet of Classic and Spirit of Tradition yachts. This 19.6nm race will be the first of three day races culminating in the Eggemoggin Reach Regatta on August 6. The race is open to all monohull Classic and Spirit of Tradition yachts at least 28' LOA with a valid CRF rating certificate. Each yacht must tow a proper dinghy; no toys, please. Failure to do so will result in time penalty and disqualification from winning any prize.

This year's Castine Classic event will celebrate the glorious early-20th-century designs of Nathanael Herreshoff. On Wednesday, August 3, notable examples of Herreshoff's genius will be on exhibition at the Castine Town Dock, including 49' Bar Harbor 31 **Desperate Lark** (built in 1903); 44' NY-30 **Cara Mia** (built in 1905); 58' P-Class **Joyant** (built in 1911); and recently restored 72' NY-50 **Spartan** (launched in 1913). At 1600 hrs these yachts will be honored at a symposium in Delano Hall, Maine Maritime Academy. The symposium will illuminate the finer details of the restorations of **Spartan** and other Herreshoff yachts, all of which relied heavily on the drawings, photographs and files of the Herreshoff archives housed at the Hart Nautical Collections of the MIT Museum in Cambridge, Massachusetts. Kurt Hasselebalch, the Hart Nautical curator, will chair the discussion among a panel of restorers, owners and sailors of Herreshoff yachts.
